

  - Michigan Refs Registration, Learning and Course Management [1303]
    - Reminder on where to get Laws of the Game
    - Ho to Print a Referee ID card



- There are a LOT of DIFFERENT Leagues / Competitions in the State
  - You have to review the Rules of Competition for each match
    - Substitution expectations?
    - Breakout Line?
    - Other stuff????
  - You need to discuss Rules of Competition in your PRE-GAME Conference
    - Make sure you are all on the same page!
  - Your Assignor can help on where to find the Rules of Competition

- Refereeing the game you are at
  - Please be sure to be calling the fouls needed to control the game being played
    - not the game you are used to playing
      - Tending to let it get "a bit rough", to paraphrase one observer
  - Common in U12 U14 play, particularly when refereed by an upper division youth player
    - Just because you and your teammates play through physical play doesn't mean evetone else can do it
    - Or wants to do it

- Remember the Players' Age and SAFETY
  - We won 5-1
  - One of our goals was scored with one of our players on the ground with a possible concussion

- Know what to look for
  - In a challenge, the challenging player "dips" his/her shoulder right before or as they make contact
    - Is it a fair challenge, or is the challenger being careless with the amount of force being used?
    - Watch for the key the dipped shoulder and make a decision as the play unfolds
  - Not everyone who falls down has been fouled
  - Just because they haven't fallen down doesn't mean they were not fouled

- U15 Female (Elite) game
- Center Ref went to give a yellow card and didn't have it in his pocket.
- He ran to his bag on the "sidelines" and ...
- ... still couldn't find it, so girl never received a yellow card
